

Dr. Campbell is Senior Vice President, Chief Quality and Patient Safety Officer at Erlanger Health in Chattanooga, TN. As part of the Patient Safety and Quality Team, Dr. Campbell leads efforts in quality improvement and education, safety, data analytics, patient experience and accreditation. Prior to joining Erlanger, he was Director, Clinical Improvement and Analytics at the Children's Hospital of The King's Daughters in Norfolk, VA, and Director of Clinical Policy and Analytics at Shriner's Hospitals for Children. Dr. Campbell is also Associate Professor at the University of Tennessee's College of Medicine, Chattanooga, and Adjunct Professor for the Haslam College of Business's Physician Executive MBA (PEMBA) Program at the University of Tennessee, Knoxville. He has also served as an examiner for the Malcolm Baldrige National Quality Award.

He received his BA in Psychology from the University of Cincinnati, his MA in Experimental Psychology from East Tennessee State University, and his PhD in Cognitive and Neural Sciences from the University of South Florida. He studied at the University of Amsterdam, the Netherlands, on a post-doctoral fellowship.
