AI MEETS SENIOR CARE - TOOLS, TRUTHS AND THE ROAD AHEAD

Logan Essig is the founder and president of Informed Medical, a communication and risk disclosure platform that helps skilled nursing and assisted living providers reduce litigation and improve engagement with residents and families.

With over a decade of experience as a licensed nursing home administrator, Logan led multiple facilities to 5-star ratings and became known for his hands-on leadership and operational excellence. Drawing on those experiences, he developed a technology solution designed to reduce conflict and improve outcomes in senior care. Today, he partners with providers across the country to help them do more with less through strategic software adoption.
