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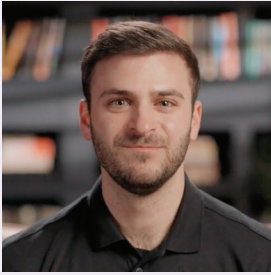

VIRTUAL CONTRAST SUPERVISION: IMPLEMENTATION, CLINICAL OUTCOMES, AND BEST PRACTICES

DOR SHOSHAN, MD

Dor Shoshan, MD, is a board-certified diagnostic radiologist and the Founder and CEO of ContrastConnect, the nation's largest virtual contrast supervision platform. Under his leadership, ContrastConnect partners with more than 400 outpatient imaging facilities and hospital systems nationwide, supervising over one million contrast exams annually - ensuring patient safety during contrast reactions and helping facilities meet federal and state requirements for Direct Supervision of Level II diagnostic imaging. Having moved to the United States at age 10 and grown up working in his family's business, Dor brings both clinical expertise and entrepreneurial drive to building practical, scalable solutions at the intersection of medicine and technology.

Dor earned his medical degree from the University of Arizona College of Medicine - Phoenix and completed his diagnostic radiology residency at Creighton University College of Medicine - Phoenix. In 2025, he was named to the Radiology Business 40 Under 40 list in recognition of his contributions to advancing the field.



ALTON SKAGGS, MD

Alton Skaggs is Chief Medical Officer of ContrastConnect, where he leads clinical strategy, physician education, and medical protocol development for the largest nationwide provider of remote contrast supervision. He is also an emergency radiologist at the University of California, San Diego (UCSD), caring for patients at a regional Level I trauma center. A graduate of the UC Davis School of Medicine, where he was elected to the Alpha Omega Alpha Honor Medical Society, and a summa cum laude graduate of UC San Diego, Alton is passionate about medical education, contrast safety, systems improvement, and leveraging technology to improve access, quality, and efficiency in radiology practice.

In addition to his clinical practice, he serves as Radiology SmartBank Director for TrueLearn and as an advisory board member for Medality. Outside of medicine, Alton is an avid surfer and multi-instrumentalist who enjoys spending his off days writing, recording, and producing original music.

BEYOND THE TEXTBOOK: THE “REAL-WORLD” LEADERSHIP LESSONS THEY DON’T TEACH IN SCHOOL

During his career he led complex healthcare organizations, developed leadership teams, and navigated the real-world challenges healthcare leaders face every day. His presentations combine relatable storytelling, humor, and actionable leadership insights that audiences can immediately apply in their organizations.

Jeff holds a Bachelor of Science degree from Lipscomb University in Nashville, Tennessee, and an MBA from the University of Alabama. He is a certified executive coach through the International Coaching Federation (ICF) and a certified facilitator through the Association for Talent Development (ATD). He is also a Lifetime Fellow of the American College of Healthcare Executives (ACHE).

After retiring from hospital leadership in 2017, Jeff founded Whitehorn Coaching & Consulting, where he now works with healthcare leaders and organizations across the country.
